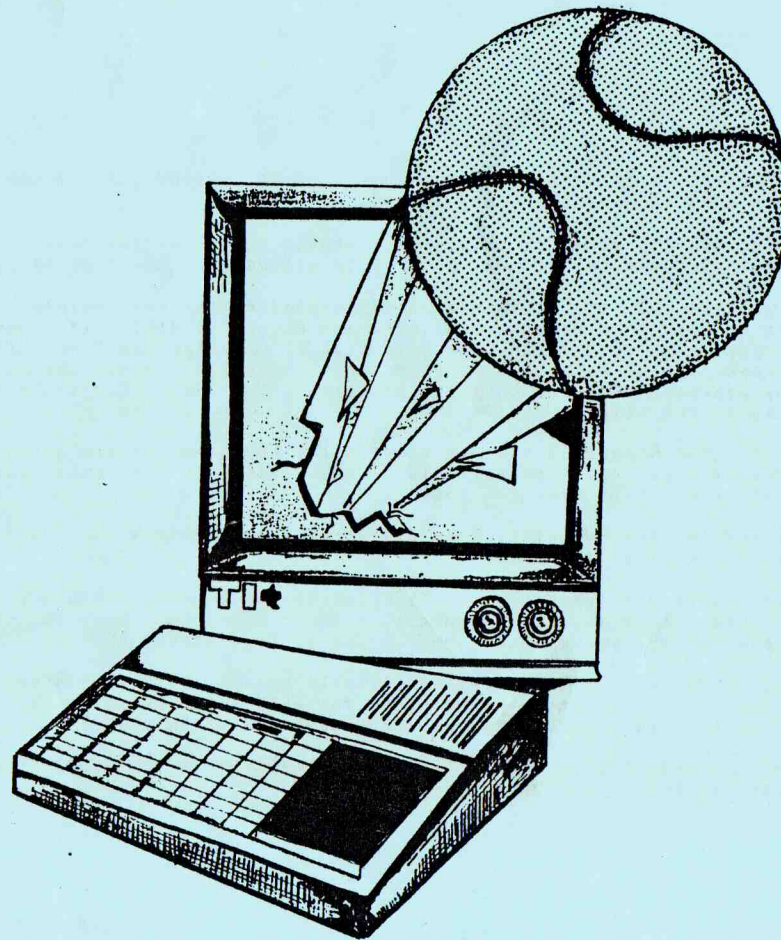


MICRO-TENNIS



MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

After the title screen is displayed, press any key to continue, if no key is pressed a demo game is displayed and played.

NOTE: Once the playing field is displayed, choose the color you desire for the tennis field by pressing FCTN 1, 2, or 3 to select red, green or blue.

If a key is pressed when the title screen is displayed, the next screen allows the selection of degree of number of players and degree of difficulty :Novice, Amateur, or Pro. Make your difficulty selection by pressing the E or X (Up and Down arrow) keys. After selecting the level of difficulty, choose the number of players by pressing the S or D (Right or Left) arrow keys. Press the ENTER key to progress to the playing field.

One player selection means you will be playing the computer. A two player selection means you and a friend will play. A selection of Demo will cause the computer to play an entire game for you.

When playing against the computer, your player will be in black and the computer's player will be in blue.

Use the joysticks to move your player. The fire button controls when the racket swings. The game allows some ball control, such as spin, English, etc. This control is acquired by experimenting and by practicing hitting the ball

Scoring - The player who is serving the ball will receive 15 points when the other player does not return a serve, 1) The ball has bounced no more than once 2) the ball is returned to the servers court out of bounds.
